

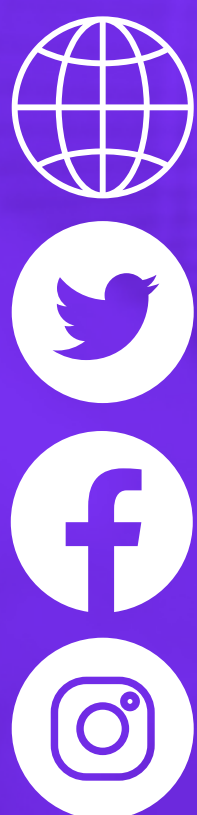

**WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?**

This SQA accredited course will build confidence and help you develop soft skills in communication, empathy, and critical thinking and how you can use data to drive change. It will utilise the most up to date business tools, technologies, and methodologies such as Scrum Agile and Design thinking.

The course will cover:

- Data ethics, data bias
- Understanding GDPR
- Data security
- Data management
- Open data
- Data science life cycle
- Introducing AI, machine learning and big data concepts.

You will also learn data cleaning, transformation, visualisation, storytelling and how to utilise statistics to interpret the data. The course will culminate in a large data project.

These data skills are essential in helping you access a variety of job roles in procurement, business analysis, project management, data analysis as well as in roles within sustainability and renewables.

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COURSE DELIVERY**

This course is delivered fully online via engaging workshops, videos, and mini projects. Classes will run **Monday–Thursday** mornings with online support available in the afternoons.

You will follow an Agile/Scrum technique for progressing through this course, with short term goals set at regular intervals, review and reflected on before moving on. We will work in weekly sprints, during which you will plan your activities for the week, set your goal and reflect on progress at the end of the sprint

Agile/Scrum techniques encourage **communication, collaboration, creativity and critical thinking.**

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AM I ELIGIBLE?

You are eligible for a fully-funded place if you:

- are aged 25 or over
- have been unemployed for 6+ months
- have been either employed or self-employed in the past
- have a National Insurance number
- reside in Scotland
